Context of School	All Saints is an average-sized primary school with approximately 260 pupils on role with school offering nursery provision for 2 year olds. The proportion of pupils eligible for free school meals is above average. Approximately three quarters of pupils are from heritages other than White British, the largest group has a Pakistani heritage. Almost three quarters of pupils speak English as an additional language and pupil mobility is high.

How have you supported other schools or middle leaders and senior leaders in your own school?	I have supported staff in my own school through staff meetings, monitoring and team teaching, to ensure that the teaching and assessment of reading and writing is consistent and accurate. I have supported subject leaders to ensure that there is progression of knowledge and skills in all curriculum areas. I have also supported them to discuss the impact that their leadership has had on their subject. I have supported an English leader in another school that was new to role to interpret data, write an action plan and carry out staff meetings and monitoring to bring about improvements. At another school I supported a teacher to understand the expectations for the end of year two and to ensure that pupils made progress. I am a KS1 moderator for the local authority and have supported colleagues from many schools to make accurate teacher assessments. Additionally, I delivered a
