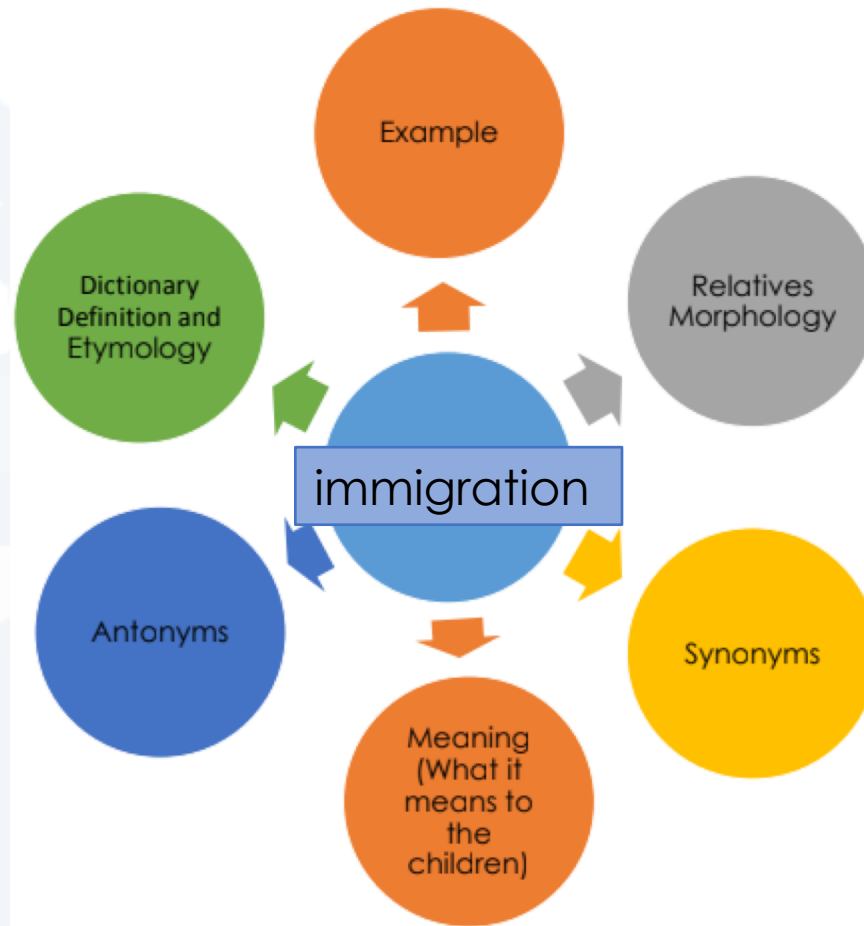

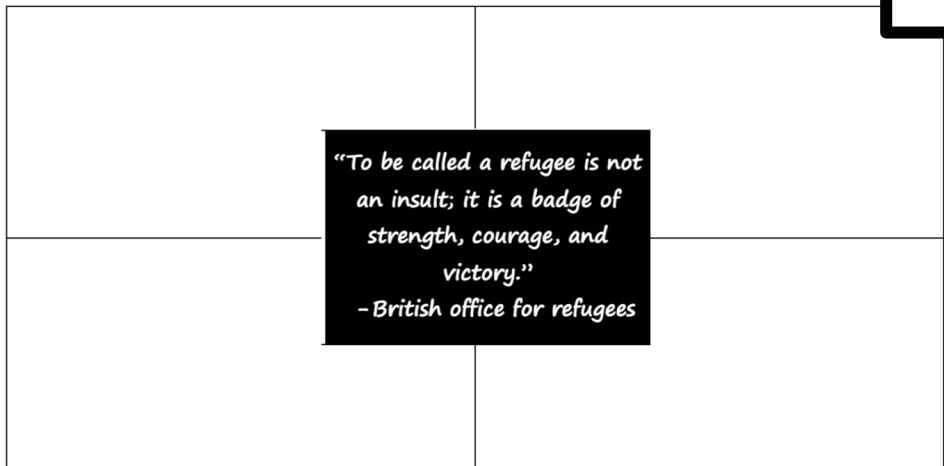


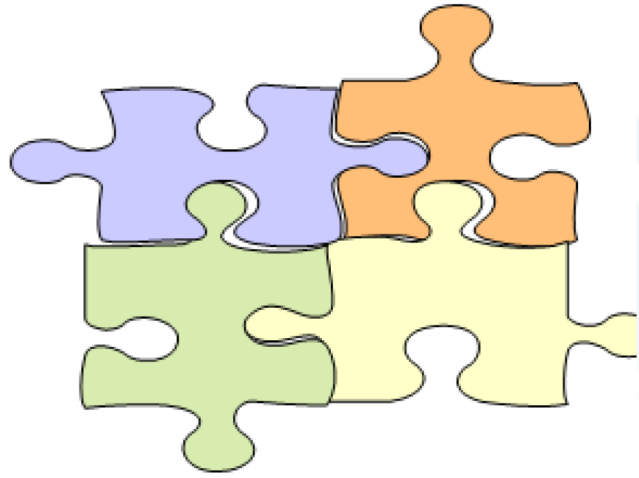
Vocabulary

|-----------|--|
| migrant | leaving leave a home country because of war or persecution (ill-treatment) |
| displaced | a person who has been forced to leave their country in order to escape war, persecution (ill-treatment), or natural disaster |
| asylum | a person who moves from one place to another, especially in order to find work or better living conditions |
| refugee | protection or safety, or a protected and safe place, given especially to someone who has left a country or place for political reasons |
